Greetings Hope Haven Friends!

Happy Spring! Our students are on a two-week break between terms right now. When they start school again on April 18th, it will be the third and final term of the current school year, which runs through mid-July. Their school year is already two thirds complete!

The secondary campus construction is proceeding full-steam ahead. The floors for the school building are completely poured. Interior walls are going up and the roof will be added soon! Then the finishing work will begin – both on the interior and the exterior. The dormitories and water tanks are also well underway. With a planned opening date in September for the start of the next school year, timing is critical. **We pray daily that God will continue to bless the construction effort.** Please join us in praying!



It's Hope Haven's 10th anniversary this year! God has been moving and working in this community through Hope Haven since April of 2012 when 97 students gathered under an Acacia tree to begin learning. This April, we have 863 students in preschool through ninth grade –**an 800% increase in our first decade!** Once all levels of the school are fully built out and enrolled, we'll have 135 students in each of the preschool through primary grades, and 160 students in each of the secondary grades for a total of 2,175 students. Wow!



All glory to God for His blessing and provision for this amazing ministry in Rwanda. Education is the key to breaking the cycle of poverty, and the families of Murindi are looking ahead to the day when their children will be self-sufficient as well as provide a positive, Christian impact on the country of Rwanda.

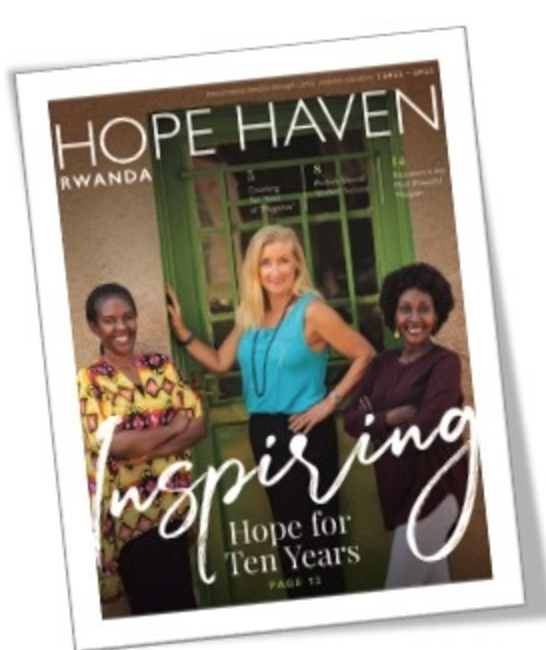
KUGABA *Korner*
